2004 Single Vineyard Reserve Shiraz – 4 ½ Glasses

Medium bodied; blackberry and mulberry fruit together with splashes of apricot and spice (Viognier at work) are supported by quality French oak and soft tannins

2005 Single Vineyard Reserve Chardonnay – 4 ½ Glasses

Light straw green; an attractive wine developing slowly; citrusy minerality gives life and zip; subtle French oak; 200 dozen.

2004 Single Vineyard Shiraz – 4 ½ Glasses

Clean and aromatic with sweet fruit on the bouquet and like wise on the palate, then fine, savoury tannins; a neat book end.

Rating: 91, Drink: 2012, Price: \$20

2004 Bullock Rd Cabernet Shiraz – 4 Glasses

Has far more substance and weight than its price and regional description might suggest; ripe blackberry, black currant and spice fruit; controlled oak and tannins. Will improve. Amazingly a 60:40 blend from de-classified Mt Jagged Vineyard wine.

2006 Semillon Sauvignon Blanc – 4 Glasses

Pale straw-green; a spotlessly clean, tight, crisp style offering delicate herb, snow pea and asparagus fruit; dry finish.

Rating: 88, Drink: 2012, \$15

2004 Single Vineyard Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon – 4 Glasses

Medium red-purple; mint, leaf, earth and berry aromas and flavours; not withstanding the alcohol, light to medium bodied, with fine tannin support.
